## 2018 State Fair Judges Breakfasts and Volunteer Snacks

Below is a chart of when, and what your club should bring for the Judges breakfasts and snacks for the volunteers.

**Food Volunteers: Enter through Gate 4 off San Pedro. You must come from the South to make a right turn—no left turns during the fair.** Tell them at the gate that you have *Flower Show Entries*. Come through the second gate and park at the back door to the flower building. Have food there between 8:00 and 8:30 a.m. There are approximately 20 Judges at each show. Bring Judges breakfast items through the connecting door from the flower building to the School Arts Building’s and deliver to the back far corner. Do not leave Judges breakfast items in the Flower building’s room where the volunteer food is to be placed. It never makes it to the Judges!

**Water, soft drinks, coffee & tea will be provided by our Fair Budget. You do not need to bring these items this year.**
